Ant foragers that you see make up only between 5-10% of the colony. The rest of the colony are tending the brood, tending to the queen and/or maintaining the nest. The treatment we provide allows for the foragers to translocate our pesticides back to the colony to be spread by grooming. We often use nonrepellent pesticides that are also attractants. Thus, you may immediately see more ants in the first day or two as our pesticides are slow killing to allow for the translocation process to occur. Approximately 60% of the time, a 1-time treatment will be enough. We share any conducive conditions with our customers that should be addressed in a timely fashion such as clogged gutters, draining issues, leaks, exterior conditions (dead tree stumps, landscaping upkeep, stacked firewood & mulch). If after two weeks you are still seeing ants, we offer an upgrade to 3 treatments for the price of 2 at the standard rate and offer a 6-month warranty against infestation to compliant customers/tenants who address our concerns. The use of any other pesticide product may interfere with the effectiveness of our treatment and will void any and all applicable warranties.

To properly prepare your home for treatment of ants, use the following guidelines to help maximize control:

- 1. Empty cabinets under sinks in the kitchen and bathrooms, as well as other places where ants have been observed such as food pantries/cabinets. Empty out the cabinets and drawers above and below sink. Allow access to the plumbing areas beneath and around sinks, etc.
- 2. **Remove food sources**. Make sure all food is always secured in sealed containers to encourage ants to eat our bait and then share with other ants through trophallaxis and to prevent the reinfestation of ants.
- 3. Empty out any other areas where ants have been seen or suspected so our pest control professional can properly treat them. Any areas to be treated must be properly prepared so access can be made to the area.
- 4. **Declutter** your apartment or home. Excess boxes, storage and other items allow pests access to more harborage in areas that cannot be treated. Declutter in areas that are conducive to ant infestation, such as in the kitchen, under kitchen sinks, bathrooms and other areas.
- 5. Remove all pets and children prior to treatment. Fish tank filters and air pumps must be turned off and the tank covered with plastic. After treatment allow chemical treatment to dry for at least 3 hours prior to reentry.
- 6. After the treatment, **do not use any other chemicals or pest control products**. They may interfere with the materials we used. Furthermore, **don't wipe down the areas treated afterward**, since it may remove the materials that are intended to provide ongoing control of the ants.

Note:

- A1 No Nonsense Pest Control uses a combination of baits, dusts, liquids, traps, glue boards, etc. to properly treat your home. Some products (such as baits and other pesticide formulations) take longer to have full effect due to the nature of the control. Residents' cooperation is essential to eliminate or reduce ant population. Therefore, 100 percent control does not take place immediately in almost every situation. There is no guarantee that a one-time treatment will eliminate the infestation. Some situations need multiple or ongoing treatment at additional cost to address the problem. We offer an upgrade to 3 treatments for the price of 2 at the then standard rate. We share any conducive conditions with customers and offer a 6-month infestation warranty to compliant customers/tenants who address our concerns.
- Proper preparation and cleaning are key! Sanitizing and de-cluttering the home removes food and water sources and harborages that the ants need. When there is an absence of such food sources, the ants tend to eat more bait, resulting in better control.

Ant treatment involves the use of chemicals and in some cases Ant treatment may result in property staining even when applied in accordance with manufacturers' guidelines. The property owner/resident understands this and not withstanding the risk of staining wants to proceed with treatment and waives the right to seek damages for staining and/or damages caused by moving of furniture/appliances that may arise from treatment.
