To properly prepare your home for treatment of cockroaches, use the following guidelines to help assure control:

- 1. Empty out all drawers and cabinets** in the kitchen and bathrooms, as well as other places where roaches have been observed. Empty out the cabinets and drawers above and below sinks. Allow access to the plumbing areas beneath and around sinks, etc. All food should be stored in sealed containers. All plates, silverware, pots and pans, glasses and other food serving items should be washed and placed in large garbage bags and sealed prior to treatment.
- 2. Degrease and Sanitize before the treatment.** Roaches thrive on grease and just about any other organic matter. They eat meats, grease, starchy foods, crumbs, sugar and more. Degrease and sanitize the cabinets, drawers, stove, refrigerator, and other appliances, countertops – anywhere grease and other organic matter may be. Grease can also accumulate under refrigerators, stoves and other appliances as well. Move the appliances out to thoroughly clean under them.
- 3. Empty out any other areas** where cockroaches have been seen or suspected so the pest control professional can properly treat. Any areas to be treated must be properly prepared so access can be made to the area.
- 4. Declutter** your apartment or home. Excess boxes, storage and other items allow pests access to more harborage in areas that cannot be treated. Declutter in areas that are conducive to roach infestation, such as in the kitchen, under kitchen sinks, bathrooms and other areas.
- 5. Remove all pets and children prior to treatment. Fish tank filters and air pumps must be turned off and the tank covered with plastic. After treatment allow chemical treatment to dry for at least 3 hours prior to reentry.**
6. After the treatment, **do not use any other chemicals or pest control products.** They may interfere with the materials the pest professional used. Furthermore, **do not wipe down the areas treated afterward**, since it may remove the materials that are intended to provide ongoing control of the roaches.
7. After pest control treatment all food serving items should be thoroughly washed again prior to reusing.
8. Upon treatment, remove all dead roaches daily. Discard them in garbage containers located outside the residence.

Note:

- A1 No Nonsense Pest Control uses a combination of baits, dusts, liquids, traps, glue boards, etc. to properly treat your home. Some products (such as baits and other pesticide formulations) take longer to have full effect due to the nature of the control. Residents' cooperation is essential to eliminate or reduce cockroach population. Therefore, 100 percent control does not take place immediately in almost every situation. A single treatment may not fully eliminate the infestation, especially if over-the-counter products have been used, as they can reduce the effectiveness of our treatment. Ongoing or additional treatments may be needed to completely resolve the issue, with each treatment incurring an additional cost..
- **Proper preparation and cleaning are key!** Sanitizing and de-cluttering the home removes food and water sources and harborage that the roaches need. When there is an absence of such food sources, the roaches tend to eat more bait, resulting in better control.

Cockroach treatment involves the use of chemicals and in some cases Cockroach treatment may result in property staining even when applied in accordance with manufacturers' guidelines. The property owner/resident understands this and not withstanding the risk of staining wants to proceed with treatment and waives the right to seek damages for staining and/or damages caused by moving of furniture/appliances that may arise from treatment.
